0143.2 - BOARD REPRESENTATIVE

In order to increase communication between students and the Board of Education, and to foster an understanding of the democratic form of government, the Board offers the opportunity for direct pupil representation to the Board.

The student representative will be a member at large of the student body and as a junior or senior, will run in the general election that governs the selection to the student council. The student will be interviewed and briefed by the high school principal, Superintendent, and meet the existing criteria prior to election.

The "term of office" will be for a period of one year commencing July 1 of each year. The student representative will be expected to adhere to the by-laws and policies adopted by the Pequannock Township Board of Education.

The representatives will be subject to the following guidelines:

- 1. May attend all open work, regular and special sessions of the Board that are open to the public. The representative may participate fully in Board deliberations at all meetings, but shall have no official vote;
- 2. Will be excused from all Executive sessions of the Board;
- 3. Will receive meeting agendas;
- 4. Student representatives will not have access to records of other students or staff or any other information that the general public is not entitled to.
