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2426 – STUDY SKILLS

The Board of Education believes that an essential part of a child's education is the development of skills and work habits that promote self-efficacy, independent learning, and that enhance the learning experience.

The Superintendent shall develop, in consultation with appropriate teaching and administrative staff, K-12 articulated skills and habits necessary for success in each course and grade level. Skills and habits should be introduced and reinforced at all grade levels and in all appropriate courses.

Professional development will be made available for teachers requiring assistance for teaching the necessary skills and habits. Every reasonable effort should be made to convey to parents and/or legal guardians the importance of their cooperation and reinforcement of these skills and habits, which are essential for learning and development.
